



Mountain Go-Cart and Scooter Rental Conditions and Operating Instructions

- Use of a mountain cart is only permissible with a valid ticket.
- Driving and riding on the mountain go-cart and scooter route is at the user's own risk and it is forbidden to stray from the marked route! Road traffic regulations must be observed.
- Alcoholised persons are prohibited from driving mountain go-carts and riding scooters without exception.
- Driving style and speed must conform to personal ability and local conditions (terrain and the state of the track).
- Children from the age of 10 and a minimum height of 150 cm may drive or ride alone if physically fit in the presence of an adult supervisor.
- A safety helmet must be worn at all times. Loan of a helmet is included in the charge.
- The user must check the functioning of the mountain cart or scooter, especially the brakes, before commencing the ride.
- Mountain go-cart: The left brake lever brakes the left rear wheel, the right brake lever brakes the right rear wheel.
- Scooter: The left brake lever activates the front brake, and the right brake lever the rear brake. Make greater use of the rear brake (right brake lever)!
- Stopping is only allowed on the right of the track!
- The mountain go-cart or scooter and helmet must be handed in at the middle station of the Smaragdbahn.
- Accidents and damage must be reported immediately at the middle station of the Smaragdbahn or by calling +43 (0) 6565 6405-64!
